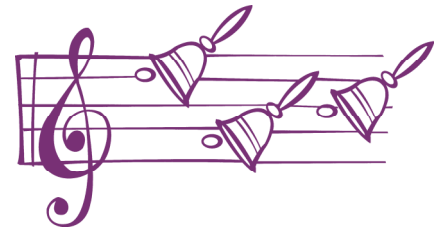

age are encouraged to take part in the worship service.

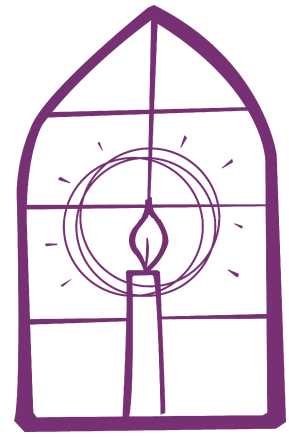


The Toddler Zone is part of the worship space, and provides a special place for families with babies and toddlers to "spread out" with their parents.
